DUTIES:

This position will monitor Arkansas public school districts for compliance with state and federal regulations governing special education programs for students with disabilities as required by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Provide technical assistance regarding special education programs and participate in due process procedures of conflict resolution.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Successful applicant must possess a current Arkansas teacher license or be eligible for the same. Master's degree in special education/educational administration or a related field; a minimum of five years experience teaching in the public school and ability to travel extensively both in-state and out-of-state.

SPECIAL APPLICATION INFORMATION:

Only completed application with work history will be accepted. The work history section of the application must be completed. We do not accept resumes in lieu of completing this section.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

The formal education equivalent of a bachelor's degree in public administration, educational administration, education, or related field; plus three years of experience in education, public school administration, or related field. Additional requirements determined by the agency for recruiting purposes require review and approval by the Office of Personnel Management. Other job related education and/or experience may be substituted for all or part of these basic requirements, except for certification or licensure requirements, upon approval of the qualifications review committee.
