Schools designated as in School Improvement Year 2 or beyond are required to offer choice and supplemental services. Schools designated to be in first-year school improvement are required to offer choice. If choice options are not available, schools are encouraged to offer supplemental services.

The local educational agency (LEA) will be required to comply with guidelines as stated in the No Child Left Behind, Public School Choice Non-Regulatory Guidance, dated June 13, 2005.

The Non-Regulatory Guidance document will provide specific guidelines on the LEA responsibilities in notifying parents and monitoring the services for the purpose of improving academic achievement as well as requirements for provision of choice and SES. The local educational agency (LEA) will be required to comply with guidelines as stated in the No Child Left Behind, Supplemental Educational Services Non-Regulatory Guidance.

While non-Title 1 schools are not required to use the providers approved by the State, they are required by Arkansas law to provide supplemental educational services.
