



ACSIP Plans must include a separate action addressing each of the following components of Parental Engagement:

- Family Kits
- No less than two parent/teacher conferences
- Parenting books, magazines and other materials regarding responsible parenting through the library, advertise the current selection, and give parents an opportunity to borrow these materials.
- Publish notice in the newspaper at the end of the school year honoring parents who attend all parent-teacher conferences scheduled by the school
- Parent Center with parenting resources available
- Engage parents in other activities that promote responsible parenting
- "Parents Make a Difference" evenings- a report is given on the state of the school and an overview of what students will be learning; how students will be assessed; what parents should expect for their child's education; and how parents can assist and make a difference
- Volunteer resource book- listing the interests and availability of volunteers for school staff members' use including parent survey
- Statements attesting to the school district's commitment to parental involvement and distribute the statements to parents of students
- Schools process for resolving parental concerns
- Seminars to inform the parents of high school students about how to be involved in the decisions affecting course selection, career planning, and preparation for post-secondary opportunities.
- Alumni advisory committee
- Tips for how parents can foster their child's success and contact employers about including these with payroll checks
- Parent facilitator
