1. Write and count numbers from 0 to 20.
2. Count the number of objects and match with the correct written number.
3. With help, understand addition and subtraction.
4. Recognize basic shapes (squares, circles, rectangles).
5. Sort objects (color, size shape).
6. Identify coins (pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters).
7. Learn that clocks measure time and rulers measure length.
8. Recognize different ways of measuring time (weeks, months).
9. Identify number words (zero to ten).
10. Know the meaning of "more than" and "less than."
11. Understand a simple graph.
12. Can create patterns. 
13. With help, solve simple word problems.



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
