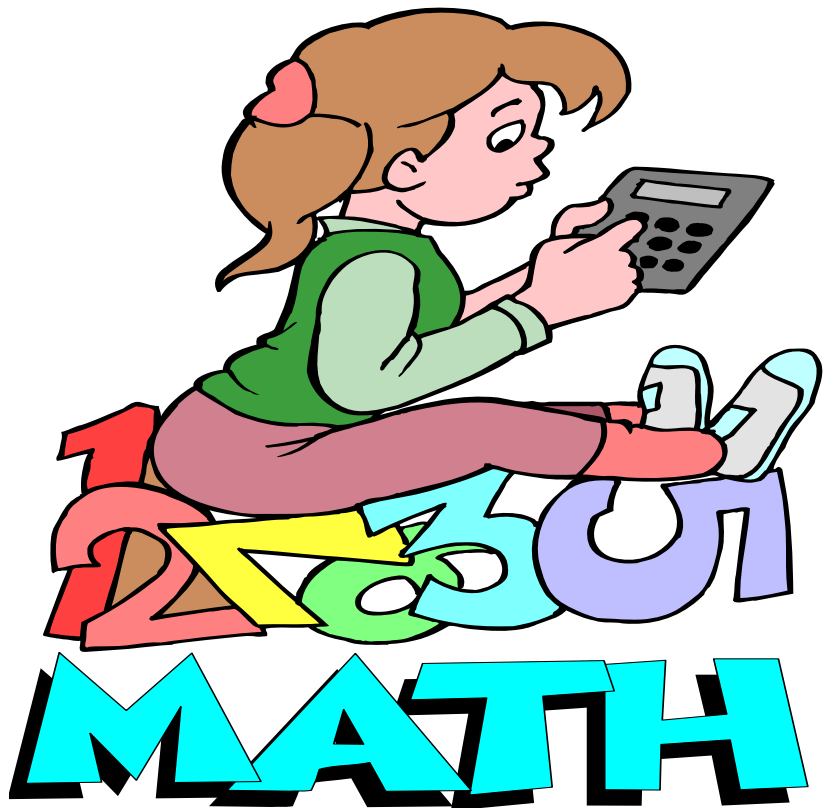

1. Make an effort to help your child with homework assignments.
2. Establish a regular study time and provide a quiet place for working.
3. Help your child see math as a thinking process rather than memorization. (Ask them how they came up with the answer).
4. Show your child how problem-solving math relates to everyday activities. (Example- getting change back from a sales person)
5. Praise your child's efforts to learn. Always be positive when helping him/her.
6. Use manipulatives found around the house such as beans, marbles, yardsticks, etc. to make math more fun.
