Listed below are some of the things you can expect your child to learn in AR Public School Kindergarten. This is only a sample and is not intended to include everything that will be taught throughout the year.

1. Learn by watching and gathering information from surroundings.
2. Identify body parts (hands, feet, head, legs, arms).
3. Identify the five senses (hearing, seeing, smelling, tasting, touching).
4. Know the difference between living and non-living things.
5. Identify farm animals, zoo animals, house pets, and wild animals.
6. Identify parts of a plant (flower, leaves, root, stem).
7. Identify basic life needs (water, food, air).
8. Recognize months and seasons.
9. Know the difference between solids and liquids.
10. Group objects by size, shape, and color.
