

CLOSING REVIEW ACTIVITY: Ending With a Bang?

SUPPLIES NEEDED: -Un-inflated balloons, review questions below cut into strips.

INSTRUCTIONS: Place a review question inside each balloon. Just before the closing, as a review inflate the balloons and tie. There should now be a review question inside each inflated balloon.

Give individual participants an inflated balloon. Ask them to pop their balloons one at a time and read the review question inside. You may ask the “popper” to answer the question, or the entire class can volunteer answers.

Suggested Review Questions

Who is the most important person in a Student-Led Conference? Why

How many Student-Led Conferences should be held in a school year?

What should be included in an Elementary Level Student Folder?

What should be in a Middle School/Junior High Folder?

What is the Kuder? How can it be helpful to a student?

C A P S stands for? How is it used?

What should be included in a High School Folder?

The teacher’s primary role in a Student-Led Conference is?

A follow-up procedure should include?
