Presented by
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FY2009 Draft Eligible Services List

- a clarification that Ethernet is an eligible digital transmission technology.
- a clarification that email archiving is an ineligible component of an email service. The draft also clarifies that email storage is limited to eligible email files and is not intended for email archiving.
- a proposal to list intranet web hosting as an ineligible feature of an eligible web hosting service.
- a clarification that Video On-Demand servers are not eligible for discounts.
- a clarification that softphones are end user equipment not eligible for discounts.
- the addition of software user licenses for Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) systems.
- a reminder to providers of Interconnected VoIP services that they must contribute to the universal service fund if not de minimis.



Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM)

- filtering software
- a broader classification of basic telephone service
- dark fiber
- text messaging
- firewall service
- anti-virus/anti-spam software
- scheduling services
- telephone broadcast messaging
- certain wireless Internet access applications, such as those used on school buses to transmit information, track students, or locate buses with GPS technology

2009-2010 Tech Plan Addendum

A school district that selects new services from the 2009-2010 E-Rate Eligibility Service List (ESL) that were not included in the district's current approved technology plan is required to submit an addendum in order to comply with E-Rate application requirements. The ADE will provide a certificate of approval to the districts that have met all the criteria of the technology plan addendum.

Form 470 for FY2009

- Are seeking non-contracted tariffed or month-to-month services
- Intend to sign a new contract
- Signed a multi-year contract or a contract with voluntary extensions without first posting a Form 470 and following all of the competitive bidding rules of the program
- Filed a Form 470 that resulted in a multi-year contract or a contract with voluntary extensions but did not indicate your interest in such a contract in Item 7b of that establishing Form 470

Form 470 for FY2009

- 1. If it is on the Form 470 it must be included in the technology plan.**
- 2. If you plan on doing a Form 471 – the service or item must be on a Form 470.**
- 3. Use the Online Form 470**
- 4. Print the 470 Number and Security Code**
- 5. Describe services and items using USAC terms**
- 6. Print 3 copies**
- 7. CERTIFY the 470 after printing**

PINS

USAC's new and improved process allows for PINs to be automatically generated, mailed, and ready to be used once the applicant has certified any one of the forms. Your PIN enables the authorized person to certify program forms online and is the equivalent of your hand-written signature.

Form 471 for FY2009

1. File in the Window
2. File Online
3. Print 3 copies of the Application number and Security Code
4. Do not place ineligible services and items on your application
- 5. Complete the Item 21 at the time you complete your application – Send it with Application**
6. Print a copy of both the application and Item 21 and save an electronic copy



ITEM 21

Item 21 Attachments generally consists of these parts:

- 1. Narrative overview or description**
- 2. Line item detail and cost associated with the eligible and ineligible products and services requested**
- 3. Any additional details, if needed, such as equipment locations or other information to support the funding request**



ITEM 21

Example of INSUFFICIENT INFORMATION:

Technical services for above products @ \$48,000**
